<p>If you are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15 years old or over, and • no longer at school, and • living or working in NSW (or an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person living in specific NSW border areas), and • an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, Australian permanent humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen <p>or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a NSW apprentice or trainee <p>you may be eligible to enrol in a government-subsidised course with an approved Smart and Skilled training provider.</p>	<p>Your eligibility for specific courses depends on your previous qualifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you haven't completed a Certificate IV or higher-level qualification, you're entitled to enrol in a subsidised course up to Certificate III level. • You can enrol in subsidised training in targeted priority areas at Certificate IV, Diploma or Advanced Diploma level, depending on the availability of funding for these courses. Having completed a Certificate IV or higher-level qualification does not affect eligibility. <p>NSW apprentices and most new-entrant trainees are eligible for a government subsidy for the training that supports their apprenticeship or traineeship. Their previous qualifications do not affect their eligibility.</p>
